



Future Expansion
 Ever-increasing admissions will require American Adventures to continually expand. Two ideas are set forth below:

Historic Harbor
 If the Appomattox River is ever dredged, then a historic harbor can be built on it, west of the Interstate 95 bridge. It can offer old-time steamboat rides to City Point and beyond.

Railroad Operations
 As a by-product of fulfilling its own transportation needs, American Adventures will have a real railroad. All of its trains have 56" gauge wheels. This permits them to go anywhere in North America. The south leg of the main railroad line runs parallel to that of Norfolk Southern Railroad.
 At some future date it may be possible to utilize the potential this offers. Possibilities include bringing in visitors from Washington, Norfolk and other cities; day trip excursions, and sending the trains on tour during the slow winter season.
